

## Pre-Departure Checklist for Students Traveling through MISTI Global Seed Funds Grant

- Set up a **pre-departure meeting** with the MISTI program manager prior to your trip. (See contact information per country below)
- Register** your participation with MISTI [here](#)
- Verify that you have a **valid passport**—*expiration date should not be less than 6 months from after date of entry into country.*
- Verify if you need any type of **visa** to enter the country you are traveling to according to your nationality.
- Verify **entry and/or testing requirements** of the country you are traveling to.
- If you are at MIT on a student visa contact the **International Students Office** to find out if you are required to do anything special regarding your visa prior to your trip.
- Review with your MIT PI [MIT's Travel Policy](#). In order to travel to some countries you might be required to submit a travel waiver and be approved prior to traveling.
- Per MIT's policy you must register your trip in the [MIT Travel Registry](#). You may not travel if this is not completed.
- MIT has set up **International Travel Insurance** for MIT students traveling through MIT programs (services provided through ISOS). Please verify with your MISTI program manager if you are eligible to use it and receive information on how to use it. *Do not cancel any other insurance you might have as it will act as your secondary insurance.*
- Depending on the country you are traveling to, set up an appointment with the **MIT Travel Clinic** at least 4-6 weeks prior to departure.
- Go over the **MISTI Health and Safety Guidelines** with your MISTI program manager.
